GHP IN BRIEF

GHP is the world's largest designer and manufacturer of animatronics for theme parks, museums, dining and retail locations, and other attractions around the world. Clients include The Walt Disney Company, Universal Studios, NASA, Coca-Cola, CEC Entertainment, and hundreds more. Find out more at www.garnerholt.com

- GHP was founded in 1977 by Garner L. Holt who was then only 16 years old

- Garner's first fully-functional animatronic figure was an Uncle Sam figure built to celebrate the US Bicentennial in 1976

- Since 1977, GHP has built nearly 3,000 individual animatronic figures and hundreds of animated props and show action systems

- GHP has built more than 450 animatronic shows for Chuck E. Cheese restaurants around the world

- GHP was the first outside company allowed to create an animatronic figure for a classic Disney attraction (Jack Skellington for Disneyland's Haunted Mansion Holiday)


- Since 2000, GHP has built more than 500 animatronic figures for Disney Theme Parks. We have figures in 10 of the 11 Disney parks around the world

- Wendell the Unicyclist premiered in 1988, and is the world's only unicycle-riding animatronic figure. He performs without any visible means of support

- The majority of our figures operate using pneumatic power. Figures for Disney parks generally use hydraulic actuation due to the demands of the Disney theme park environment

- We use a number of industry control systems, but generally utilize our proprietary, in-house created control hardware and softwares

- Most of GHP's masks for animatronics are made of custom silicone



A WORLD OF MECHANICAL WONDERS

We have more than 60,000 sq ft of design and production space on our multi-acre, three building creative campus. Wendell the Unicyclist, left, and the Yeti

- We use only synthetic furs, teeth, and claws in finishing our animatronics
- The Yeti animatronic figure will premiere sometime in late 2014 and will feature 164 functions, including 54 in the face, and more than 24 in each hand
- GHP has created two of the largest animatronic figures in the world: Ursula the Sea Witch at Tokyo DisneySea, and the Maleficent Dragon at Disneyland
- In addition to our unmatched production abilities, GHP also offers full-service ride, show, attraction, and exhibit design at GHP Creative, LLC and a range of specialty items and collectibles through GHP Products, LLC
